

• Reactions to the Integrated assessment findings of the Stampriet Transboundary Aquifer system.

① - The preliminary report that was submitted on the 4th of this month, ^{the report} still had a few missing information. Therefore UNESCO-IHP will send an email on Friday (18th Dec) to inform the member states not to work on the current draft, but should wait for the final, DRAFT that will be sent on the 10th January 2016.

② The three countries will then have time to assess and scrutinise the report, and give feedback on the assessment report, not later than the 24th January 2016.

③ ONCE the countries have submitted their comments, UNESCO, will then incorporate all the comments in the report, and send back the final version NOT later than the 7th February 2016.

④ The countries will then be given, maximum one week, to endorse or not the final report. This should be done not later than the 14th February.

⑤ UNESCO then takes over for printing and so forth.

⑥ All the information approved on the assessment will be for public view on IMS. All other information will then be SPECIFICALLY approved by countries before going public.

• Recommendations for project's potential next phase.

• The assumption is that the outcomes have been generated from the assessment draft report.

• Therefore while finalising the Report, all the outcomes will be revisited.

* Activities under each outcome will be further developed as per country's need, without limiting ourselves to SDC funds, but also considering co-funding from countries of existing SADC projects.
